No, you can't use IDL DLMs. .flm and .dlm file are similar, but they describe the interface only. The actual DLM source code is very different. FL is written in C++, uses some builtin C++ types for basic data types (std::string for strings, std::complex for complex numbers), so the DLM code must be also C++. However, the object oriented approach results in simpler and more readable code, eg. keyword handling is much easier (well, if you have basic C++ knowledge :-).
