Well, here is the solution for my problem.

Look at the declaration of the SUBROUTINE TRMESH in

<http://www.netlib.org/toms/623> or <http://www.netlib.org/toms/624>.

There you find the definition for IADJ and IEND.

But: The indices contained in IADJ and IEND are not zero-based! Even in the struct used in IDL. That's a little bit confusing. So you have to correct for that, when you use these fields for a different purpose than for TRIGRID.
