First of all, let me say that I love ps_config. I use it in many of my programs and it makes producing postscript plots so much easier.

While we are discussing these programs, I might ask the filename keyword works paths. If I call ps_start like this:

```
ps_start,filename='plot.ps'
```

the plot will sometimes appear in the directory of the program that calls ps_start and sometimes it appears in my home directory.

Sometimes it even appears in the directory that stores ps_start.pro.

Does anyone (David perhaps) have any advice about how to control where the output of ps_start appears? I am using IDL 7.0 on a Mac.
