Hi

is your problem that you get megabytes of warning texts, but execution continues?

Or do you get a run-time error and execution of your program stops, even though you do not care that some part of your data was not read correctly?

If it is the former, maybe it is better to suffer the warnings than to waste effort in suppressing them.

If it is the latter, one could put the offending read statements into an EXECUTE() call and set the QuietExecution option. Of course, this only really works if there is no important data after the read error, since that won't get read. Also, make sure that you delete the program afterwards, or forever the dark side of the force your destiny will control.
