I know my input file, and I know I could read the input lines, and treat every string section as something special or defining a mask which handles only the relevant columns and rows. That'd be too much hassle in this case as it's only trailing comments in a data file which I want to ignore and not each throw a "conversion error" message. Actually I hoped to get a useful hint, especially as I knew you as a usually very helpful person... :S
