- > It's not rectified correctly. But using the same pts file in Envi to
- > warp ,the result is all right. Could anyone tell me why?

Do you have some reason why you believe ENVI is using the same code you are? The general pattern in ENVI is that when the ENVI folks find IDL code that sucks (map projections come to mind) they write their own that does a better job. It would not surprise me at all to learn their warping routines were different (and probably superior) to those found in IDL.
