All,

I finally upgraded to 7.0.4 from 6.4.1 and so far so good. However I am fighting with a dlm and wondering if it is a 32/64 bit issue (the 7.0.4 is 64 and 6.4.1 is 32 at least on my mac). Is there a way that I can start 6.4.1 from the command line like I used to (and still do for 7.0.4)? If I type `idl` I get 704, if I type `/Applications/itt/idl64/bin/idl` I get 704, If I type `/Applications/itt/idl64/bin/bin.darwin.i386/idl` I get a bunch of errors....
