You can set the TRACKING_EVENTS keyword for any widget, and then IDL is suppose to generate events when the cursor enters and leaves the outlines of the widget. In practice, it helps if you move the cursor s--l--o--w--l--y. :-(

That is to say, I wouldn't bet a whole lot of money on an application using this functionality. :-)
