A vaguely related wish of mine is that compile_opt idl2 finally be made the default. I appreciate that ITTVIS wants to have backward compatibility, but square brackets were introduced 11 years ago, and do we still need default 16 bit integers? If there is anyone who still wants their 11 year old software packages to run without modification, ITTVIS could add a compile_opt idl1 (or compile_opt idl_ancient) command.
