I suppose it depends what you mean by "do processing". If it needs to be in a for loop, then something like this should work:

```
for i=0l,364 do begin
  ... do whatever is required to read in image i ...
  if i mod 16 ne 0 then continue
  ... do processing on image i ...
endfor
```

But it could be that you can be much more clever... hard to say without more details. Do you need to store the intermediate images? Can you read in everything and then do vector processing afterwards?
