Thanks to all those who downloaded the movie, ran it on their Mac, and then proceeded to outdo one another with compression efficiency;-) In my defense, the reason why I return the uncompressed movie is that my collaborators often (despite my best efforts) choose to treat the AVI output as raw data and do other analyses on it. However, the posts have given me some ammo when I say these movies can run on a Mac.

Now I have a general follow up question: if the software which GENERATES the AVIs works fine on PC and Linux and doesn't work on the Mac, is there a way for the Virtual Machine to return the specific errors that are being encountered? In other words, if I am not running a full version of IDL on the Mac, is there some way to debug this program remotely? For the life of me, I cannot figure out why my distributed app is not working in this one specific way (AVI generation) on one specific platform.
