Let me spew a few thoughts here, then maybe someone will give a good answer:)

It seems to me that there are a couple of ways to do this.

- One could use a dumb IDL blocking method: while 1 do begin tst=file_test(filename,/exists) if tst eq 1 then begin ;; do something here :: then delete or move the file endif wait, 10; 10 seconds delay in "real time" endwhile

- One could do a cron solution (assuming some form of *nix) just have cron call an idl script every xx minutes, the script then using file_test either does something or quits
- One could be smart and write a perl (or whatever) wrapper that watched the file for you then executed the idl script

OK, who has a really good answer?
