(accessible from the print help page)

```
print, data, format = '(2(9(f,";"))/))'
```

(f,";") ==> put a semicolon after each value
9(f,";") ==> write 9 values
(9(f,";"))/ ==> write 9 values and finish with a new line
2(9(f,";"))/ ==> write 2 times 9 values, then new line.

To skip 2 lines, put // etc
