Hi. When I try to use call_external() on a routine in shared object file which uses the threads library (on a Sun Sparc, Solaris), I get a

thr_create: Invalid argument

error whenever thr_create() is called. I understand that there are stubs for the threads calls in libc, and this is apparently why the correct routine is not getting called. Has anyone ever run into a similar problem? Does anyone know how to get around it? This is my linking command:

```
ld -i -G -o mylib.so *.o -lthread
```
