Graphics display windows for plots and GUIs built with IDL widgets all work perfectly well over X11 between Macs. I use this all the time.

What you can't get to work remotely over X11 is the Eclipse-based IDLDE. For that you'd need to use VNC or some similar screen-sharing solution.
