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Hi, I know this problem has come up before, but I was unable to find a solution that worked in the group.

The problem:

cursor,x,y,/down

or any variation results in a dead terminal and X-window. Using ctrl-c at the terminal and then clicking on the terminal works:

```
IDL> cursor,x,y,/down,/device
```

```
% Interrupted at: $MAIN$
```

```
IDL> print,x,y
```

```
522      105
```

Using "defaults write com.apple.x11 wm_click_through -bool true" has no effect. Installing the latest version of IDL (7.0.6) also had no effect. The error occurs both with IDL run remotely and locally. I've tried both versions of X11 listed in the subject. Any ideas?
