Here's a routine to produce better looking direct graphics using the same technique. You can produce a plot like this:

using a syntax very close to the usual:

```
w=obj_new("gmwindow",title="gmwindow")
```

```
w->plot,indgen(20),findgen(20)^2,psym=-5,ytitle="an axis  
title",background=200,color=0,charsize=2
```

```
w->oplot,indgen(20),400-findgen(20)^2,psym=-4,color=128
```

```
w->xyouts,10,200,"a label",color=0,charsize=3
```
