>>> v7.0.6. seems to be like some reduced functionality mode. The warning
>>> reads:
>>> "Support for Secure Socket Layer (SSL) communication and other strong
>>> data
>>> encryption technologies has been removed from IDL 7.0.6. This change
>>> means
>>> that the IDLnetURL, IDLnetOGCWCS, and IDLnetOGCWMS objects can not use
>>> SSL
>>> encryption in IDL 7.06. Support for the MrSID file format has also been
>>> removed. Existing IDL programs that rely on SSL encryption or MrSID
>>> functionality will not work with IDL 7.0.6." Sounds like some licensing
>>> and/or ITAR problem to me that had to be fixed.
