David Gell writes:

> You can use the graphics keywords [xy]tickname to suppress the tick
> labels on all but the desired plot.

I usually suppress tick labels like this:

```
IDL> plot, findgen(11), xtickformat='(A1)'
```

I don't know WHY it works, but it does.

I haven't been able to figure out what the user wanted to do either, so I haven't commented, but I did have something totally different from this in mind. :-)
