;;; begin
increment =20
FOR j = 0, N-1, increment DO BEGIN
IF a gt 0 THEN BEGIN
;.....
increment=10
ENDIF ELSE BEGIN
;.....
increment=12
ENDELSE
ENDFOR
;; end
```

But the increment have not changed according to IF... ELSE ... statement..

What I want is to change the increment according to different conditions. that is, if variable a is greater than 0, the increment of the FOR loop will be 10, not its default value 20.....

Is there any solution to this problem?
