I'll just point out one other thing for the article you are writing. The nice thing about arrays of structures is that you can easily pull vectors out of the structure fields.

So, in the example yesterday, if you wanted a vector of all the "int_1" values in the third "unit" in the file, you can do this:

```
IDL> d = unpackData(data[2])
IDL> help, d
    D     STRUCT = -> <Anonymous> Array[5]
IDL> vector = Reform(d.int_1[*])
IDL> print, vector
    1     2     3     4     5
```
