If you want a softer approach I suggest downloading CDAWlib and playing around with some of the routines in there.

The CDFx GUI is a nice graphical way [you Matlab users like GUI's right?] of coming to terms with the contents of a given CDF quickly.

I have also found some the Berkeley CDF routines useful. They can be found in the IDL libraries for various missions [FAST, THEMIS etc]
