When I try to plot something on a ps and then convert it into png, e.g. ps_start --> loadct --> plot with color --> ps_end, /png. All other colors behave good, but the result picture is ALWAYS HAVING A TRANSPARENT BACKGROUND no matter which color I choose for it. While when plotting directly on X, the background color works fine.

Do I have to set anything up in my system? I'm currently running IDL on Ubuntu 9.04 with all the stuffs like gs, imagemagick installed with apt-get by default.
