- > I'm getting the following error in some code I've written: CLOSE: File
- > unit is not within allowed range: 133. I'm guessing I'm forgetting a
- > FREE LUN someplace, but is there a programmatic way to check to see
- > what FIDs (acquired initially via openr,...,/GET_LUN) are currently
- > "open"?

If you are opening the file with GET_LUN, either as a keyword or as the procedure, there is no need to use CLOSE. FREE_LUN will both close the logical unit number and free it up to be used over again.

Help, /FILES will tell you which files you currently have open and attached to a logical unit number.
