So you have a UTF-8 encoded file (I don't understand all this encoding things, but it seems 3-bytes for the chinese characters and 1 byte for the bracktes and the comma ).

I think the only way is to read the file unformatted (use readu). Afterwards you can do this to extract the three variables:

str="(??,??????????)"; you have to readu it from your file str=strsplit(str,"(,",/extract)

A=str[0]

B=str[1]

C=str[2]

Does this help?
