Sophie,
when reading strings, the whole line is read. So when you read in S, you
are reading nb_cols LINES.. s[0] = line0, s[1] = line1 etc. You would
have to read the whole line then separate the columns.

You can do it in one step

```
data = strarr(nbLines)
readf,lun,data
```
