at top of program:

last = -1

xpos = 0.9 ; X position in normalized coordinates

ypos = 0.9 ; Y position in normalized coordinates

within your loop:

if last ne -1 then xyouts, xpos, ypos, string(last,format='(I3)'), \$

color=!p.background ; this clears the previous number

tv, ...

xyouts, xpos, ypos, string(i,format='(I3)'), \$

color=!p.color ; this draws the number i

last = i ; store number to clear next time
