```
> spawn,'cd temp'  
> spawn,'ls -l | grep raw | awk '{print $9}' | xargs rm '
```

```
spawn, 'cd temp ; ls -l | ...'
```

this way, the cd and the ls happen in the same spawn-process. You could also do 'ls temp | grep raw\$ | xargs rm', or use find, as someone else has suggested.
