Ah, now we are getting somewhere. :-)

Your problem is that the file `linkedlist__define.pro` is not on your IDL path. (Or, it is not spelled with all lowercase letters if you are on a UNIX OS.) To use these programs, they must be saved in lowercase letters and located in a folder that is on your IDL path.

Here is an article that describes how to set up your IDL path for the Coyote and Catalyst Libraries. You would do the same thing for whatever folder holds this file.
