> and it fixed the first problem. But is there any way that I can
> selectively remove the plotted curves? for example, by clicking the
> button relevant to each curve, I want it to be off the draw window.

I think maybe you should try iPlot. :-)

If you want to interact with a plot (click buttons, for example) you are going to have to learn to write widget programs. Do you know anything about that?

If you want a curve to disappear. Draw the plot over without that curve in it. That's how it's done.
