- > When some kind of error happens, the widget hangs up and I clear it with
- > by pressing the close button. Then I use "WIDGET CONTROL,/DESTROY,
- > EVENT.TOP" and a "RETALL" after that. I return to the main and fix the bug
- > and rerun the widget. The widget comes up but accepts no events and is
- > totally incative. I have also tried "WIDGET CONTROL,/CLEAR EVENTS" and it
- > doesn't seem to help. The only solution I have found, is to restart IDL.
- > Does any one have any suggestions? Am I missing some thing very basic?

If you get an error, try simply using "RETALL" followed by "XMANAGER" at the idl> prompt. If you are not saving any widget state information in uvalues using /no_copy, this will often work just fine. If you are using uvalues with the /no_copy option, the "retall" will cause you to be unable to re-enter the xmanager successfully. In this case, I do this: "retall", close the top level widget base using the window manager (it wont always disappear immediately), then type "xmanager". This will cause the widget hierarchy to be destroyed, and you can restart it without restarting idl.

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
