```
image=byarr(300,300,3) ; define a single array
read_gif,'red.gif',image(0)
read_gif,'blue.gif',image(1)
read_gif,'green.gif',image(2)
```

Here's where I'm stuck. What parameters need I use to display this as a RGB with TV? Is there a better/easier way to go about this?
