Maarten writes:

- > There can be only one current graphics device at any time, and thus
- > you can generate only one PS file in one run. A possible solution is
- > to first run the inner loop, and then run the outer loop.

I'm not exactly sure what "one run" means. It is true that PostScript files can only be generated one at a time, but if a "run" is an IDL program, you can generate as many as you like in that program, as long as you do it one at a time. You can also generate as many "pages" of PostScript output as you like in a single PostScript file.
