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Hi guys,

I wrote a script to help me with the most common actions I always do in IDL. I copy some folders, I update some files and finally I call IDL to do some actions.

Normally I use something like this:

```
idl <<!here
    some_actions
@my_program.pro
resolve_all
save, filename='my_program.sav', /routines
exit
!here
```

It works good but I've a problem if I try to run this code inside a case statement. My idea is to execute this code as an optional argument for my script. When I try to do it I've an error:
here-document at line 127 delimited by end-of-file (wanted `!here')
unexpected end of file

I don't understand the error and I don't know if there are more options to call IDL and do some actions from a BASH script. Can anybody help ? Thanks,
