The Users'Guide for IDL 3.0 says that under Unix, file units 0,-1, and -2 are tied to stdin, stdout, and stderr, respectively.

Under VMS, these units are tied to the equivalents SYS\$INPUT,SYS\$OUTPUT, and SYS\$ERROR.

The Release Notes for IDL (version 3.\*) for Windows say that these three numbers are tied to stdin, stdout, and stderr, too.

I don't know whether there have been major changes to this in IDL 4.\*.

Isn't there a good documentation any more?
