Producing decent eps plots for publication requires extensive control over all aspects of the plot, such as the x- and y-sizes, the font sizes, etc. I've always exercised this control using direct graphics. The downside, of course, is what you see on the screen is not what ends up in the eps file when you change the device--something we have all asked to be fixed for so many years I've lost count. Once or twice a year, I try to use itools to do publication quality plots. I just tried again, and things have improved a bit, but not enough. Does anyone know how to specify the x- and y-sizes of the bounding box in an eps file written from an iplot window? All I can seem to get is 6"x4".
