David Fanning writes:

> Here is an odd little thing that is totally reproducible.
> I'm trying to write a file, and I want to give the user
> a chance to change the filename with Dialog_Pickfile on
> my IDL 7.1.2 Windows 64-bit OS. I type these commands:
>
> filename = 'polarstereo_np_304x448_25000m.lat'
> filename = Dialog_Pickfile(FILE=filename)
>
> When the dialog comes up, the name looks like it has
> been chopped in half. It looks like "304x448_25000m.lat".

It turns out, if I set the WRITE keyword in Dialog_Pickfile everything is normal. Go figure.

```
filename = Dialog_Pickfile(FILE=filename, /WRITE)
```

If I use my own title, it still truncates the starting filename:

```
filename = Dialog_Pickfile(FILE=filename, TITLE='Write')
```
