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First of all thank you for asking.

I personally approve the default behaviour for "idl2" and do not agree with "dot". IMHO "dot" will make the code less readable.

I want to propose another possible solution for compiler configuration. Put some config (xml?) file in the library directory.

This file could describe the desired compiler options for all pro-s in directory (and subdirs). So the problem remains only for mixed directories which it seems a much rarely case. Subconfigs could override upper dir config and so on (e.g. as for Apache .htaccess files). These configs could manage all possible properties that concerns underlying pro-s. Their role can be extended even to manage procedures and common block namespaces.
