> main problems has to do with the environment present in the Emacs
> session vs. your shell. I've seen segfaults in IDL based on incorrectly
> set DISPLAY parameters, and other things. Launch emacs from the shell
> with emacs -q to skip your .emacs init file, and see if that changes
> anything.

emacs -q still segfaults when I try and do anything in the IDL buffer in
emacs.

echo \$DISPLAY results in :0.0 which is, as far as I know (I'm far from a
wizard) correct

IDL, by itself, does what I ask of it, graphics-wise, X-wise, etc
