It was written to save isv and/or eps. But looking at the code, I think that if you give the keyword epsfile a png file name, it will make a PNG, because the file format is decided by the extension in the file name. I do not know for sure because I do not have an older IDL installed where I can check it. If you do use it and it works, let me know and I may change the code to indicate that it can save to other formats.
