> It is produced by the following line of code:
>
> ; Plot location of Cluj-Napoca International Airport
> if (date eq '25052009') then XYOUTS, [23.67,46.8], 'C', COLOR=253
```

Basically, it means the syntax of your XYOUTS command is wrong, and that "C" can't be used as a location variable. Maybe you meant to type this:

```
if (date eq '25052009') then XYOUTS, 23.67, 46.8, 'C', COLOR=253
```
