Thank you for your reply. Finally I got something.
Now, I'm able to run the script but only for the root user (I don't know why). For the other users I got the following message:
Warning: Cannot allocate colormap entry for default background.

This is my final script:

```
export DISPLAY=:2
/usr/X11R6/bin/Xvfb :2 -screen 0 1152x900x16 &
/usr/local/itt/idl70/bin/idl -rt=my_script.sav -args A B C
```

PS I realized that I just have to define the screen one time (/usr/X11R6/bin/Xvfb :2 -screen 0 1152x900x16 &).
Then, if the script will be executed each 10 minutes using the 1st and 3th lines it's enough
