Thanks for your reply Gianguido but this is not what I'm looking for...

I can't use ssh -X user@machine because the idea is execute the program as a script.

So, I created a SHELL SCRIPT that calls IDL:

idl -rt=program_script.sav -args A B C

And the computer runs this script automatically. I used the crontab command, so when the script is running it has no X. So the question is still the same:

- 1) Is it possible to run IDL without X?
- 2) Is there a way to activate the X before the command 'idl rt=program_script.sav -args A B C' and deactivate it after?
