Thanks for your reply Gianguido but this is not what I'm looking for..

I can't use `ssh -X user@machine` because the idea is execute the program as a script.

So, I created a SHELL SCRIPT that calls IDL:

```
idl -rt=program_script.sav -args A B C
```

And the computer runs this script automatically. I used the crontab command, so when the script is running it has no X.

So the question is still the same:

- 1) Is it possible to run IDL without X?
- 2) Is there a way to activate the X before the command '`idl -rt=program_script.sav -args A B C`' and deactivate it after ?
