>> ; Plot location of Cluj-Napoca International Airport

>> if (date eq '25052009') then XYOUTS, [23.67,46.8], 'C', COLOR=253

>

> Basically, it means the syntax of your XYOUTS command

> is wrong, and that "C" can't be used as a location

> variable. Maybe you meant to type this:

>

> if (date eq '25052009') then XYOUTS, 23.67, 46.8, 'C', COLOR=253
