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Does anyone know a easy to way to print out an array with no blanks at all?

I have an array of strings like

```
a = [[' cat','d o g','bi rd '],[' 1.23, ' 4. 56','  
7.89 ']]
```

```
print, a
```

```
cat, d o g, bi rd  
1.23, 4. 56, 7.89
```

I can remove most of the spaces with,

```
print, STRCOMPRESS(a, /REMOVE_ALL)
```

```
cat, dog, bird  
1.23, 4.56, 7.89
```

But what I need to output is,

```
cat,dog,bird  
1.23,4.56,7.89
```

No blanks at all. Any ideas?
