Hi All,

I have 2 questions with regards to plotting. I hope that these are not too basic:

1. How do you make the plotting grid more thick when using a simple 'plot' procedure? I see how to make characters and lines thicker with the 'thick' and 'charthick' keywords, but I don't see how to make the axis thicker.

If it is relevant, I am plotting to postscript and I want the plots to show up better in presentations.

2. Completely unrelated - In the plot labels, I wish to use more sophisticated symbols, such as a character with a ~ above or a character with both a subscript and superscript which are not offset. Are there any easy ways to do this in IDL?

References to sample code or tutorials are also great.
