I have to do stuff on about 10,000 files, hundreds of times over and it takes a while

In playing, I have found that...

spawn, 'cat in_filename |uniq >out_filename'

actually takes a lot more time than

reading each file in and uniq and writing out in idl

I haven't really use spawn too much until recently when I found it is simple to use for certain unix commands but hadn't considered what the overhead might be. Is there a standard response to this? Avoid spawns within loops?
