> Currently, we have your entire library explicitly checked into our repository. I will soon  
> move that to externals definitions of a tag+revision# - do you have a list (or a link to a  
> list) of your trac/svn project URLs on your blog? Or do they all use the same URL naming  
> convention?

Yes, each project has its own svn/Trac.

svn URL is `http://svn.idldev.com/${PROJECT}`  
Trac site is `http://${PROJECT}.idldev.com`

where `${PROJECT}` is:

idldoc  
mgunit  
cmdline\_tools  
dist\_tools  
ridl

My regular library doesn't have a Trac site, but the svn URL is:

`http://svn.idldev.com/idllib`

I should probably bring that one into line with the others.
