Thanks for sharing this useful adjustment of MAP_GRID.

However, I'm still quite annoyed with the fact that for a non-rectangular projection (e.g. mollweide, stereographic) MAP_GRID produces grid lines only for a segment of the latitude ring and misses the upper and/or lower edges of the map plot. But if you use /BOX_AXES in the same plot, it borders the full rectangular map extent (which is "correct" as IDL plots the map for the rectangular area instead of the segment limits). Any ideas for this problem?
